## From The Dean . . .

In February, I was fortunate to spend time with our newly installed Presiding Bishop: the Most Rev. Michael Curry. He was a keynote speaker at the annual conference of the Consortium of Endowed Episcopal Parishes and also spent an afternoon with the Rectors and Deans. Bishop Curry is a powerful and dynamic Christian leader, and I believe he is ideal for the Episcopal Church at this moment in our history. At last summer's General Convention, in advance of the presiding bishop election, the house of Deputies identified two priorities for the coming decade: Evangelism and Racial reconciliation. These have been central aspects of Bishop Curry's ministry, and are certainly consistent with the priorities that Bishop Thompson has set for the Dioceses of Louisiana.



This summer, we will be welcoming our new Presiding Bishop to the Cathedral pulpit. On the evening of Sunday, July 31, we will host the opening Eucharist for the annual conference of the Union of Black Episcopalians at which Bishop Thompson will celebrate and Bishop Curry will preach. Following the service, the Diocese is hosting a festive reception, so it is sure to be an amazing and memorable evening. This event will be open to everyone, so if you are in town, I hope you will make every effort to be present to share in this historic occasion.

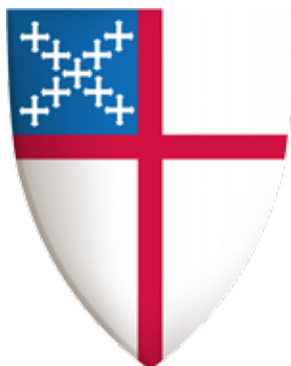

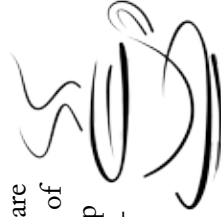
### **Baptism**
